



April – May - June 2024 Ministry Update

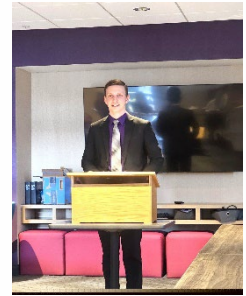
Dear Pastors, Friends, and Church Family,
