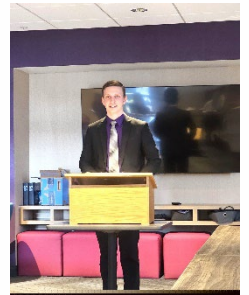
Dear Pastors, Friends, and Church Family,
