

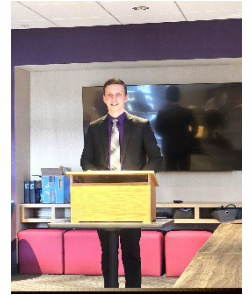

January – February 2026 Ministry Update

Dear Pastors, Friends, and Church Family,

As I write this letter, we are reflecting on another year that has passed and the new year that has begun. We are looking forward to what God has in store for the Mt Ogden Baptist Church this new year. We have been very busy these last few months and we have seen the Lord do some great things.

At the beginning of the new year, we started our Sunday School. I have been teaching on the creation for several weeks now and our folks are really enjoying this time in God's Word. Also, since we have not had as much snow this year as we normally get, we have continued to get our doorhangers out. We are excited about how the Lord is using them to reach souls for His glory. We also had the family of man that got saved as a result of the jail ministry, start calling every Sunday morning and listening in via phone to our morning service. They are from a very rural area in Iowa where there are no other solid Bible preaching churches. They are the only Christians in that community, as they are surrounded by Mennonites.



In February, we continued to teach, preach, and witness in our city. We also had another lady start calling in on the phone to listen in on our Sunday morning services. After some time in prayer, we felt the Lord was leading us to start livestreaming our Sunday morning service for those folks that do not have a good, solid, Bible preaching church to attend. I have also told both families that we are praying for God to call and send somebody to their towns to start a church where the Gospel can be preached and folks can serve our Lord.

Also, we have seen the need for a paper and tract folding machine as we are folding approximately 3,000 letters introducing our church and ministries to our community, per month, by hand. This is very time consuming and could greatly increase the number of doorhangers we would be able to put together and get out if we had access to an automatic folding machine. We are looking for a desktop with Z-fold capabilities that will work with glossy paper. Please help us pray for this need.

Other happenings for our family include: Allen turned 51 in January.
