During the month of July, we continued to get the gospel into our mission field. We also had several visitors in our services.

During our Tuesday evening services I have been preaching a series on FAITH out of Hebrews 11. On one of our Tuesday evening services, we had a couple of folks walk in a little late and sit in on our service. The Lord changed the message that night about mid ways and I was able to preach the gospel (possibly the first time they had ever heard it preached clearly). I wish I could report that they trusted Jesus as their Saviour, however, they were both high on drugs. While talking with them after the service, we discovered the guy (Kolis, 39yrs old) had a large knife sticking out of his backpack and the girl (Ivy, 23yrs old) dropped a needle filled with a combination of Meth and Heroine. As we talked with them, Ivy told us she didn't care whether she lived or died. God put a burden on our hearts that night for these people and by God's grace we started researching addictions ministries. God led us to the HOPE Addictions Ministry and we started the process of getting that set up in our church.

Also, during the month of July, my wife's nephew came out and stayed with us for a while. We were excited to get to show family where we are serving at and excited for him because this was his first time taking a Missions trip. Hopefully it won't be the last!

In August, we continued to pass out gospel tracts and talk to folks in the community. We also continued to work on getting the material designed and printed for the HOPE Ministry. We had the parking lot sealed and striped, and it looks a lot better. We have also been given several items by a Church Planter in Charlotte, NC. A special THANKS to Pastor Willie Byrd for the metal chairs for the tent ministry, the new chairs for our church, portable baptistry, as well as many other items.

We were supposed to hear back from the city on our permit for the steeple on August 8th, however, it was a couple of weeks later before we heard back, and they wanted more information. So, we are still in this process.

Also, during the month of August, our daughter, Jessica, was able to come out and spend a few days with us. What a blessing! She is planning another trip out in January and hopefully Matthew (her husband) will be able to fly out with her.
