We also had the privilege to help pass out tracts, door hangers, and flyers for several different churches in all of these states.

In July, we started in MN, then headed west to ID then on to UT for the rest of the month.

While we were in UT, we had the privilege to attend "Vision Week" at our sending church in N Logan, UT. We were encouraged as well as challenged to be faithful in God's calling. It was a blessing to see all the folks at Mt Logan once again.

Also, while in UT, we were able to go down to Ogden and work on our building. We pressure washed the outside and got it painted (pictures are on our website)! Bro. Stacy Percy and Mrs. Danette with Hands Across the Nation, brought our chairs, pulpit, and communion table out. One of our supporting churches in Wyoming has bought the furnace and a/c system. Bro. Doug Baker in Wyoming at the Western Baptist Missions Warehouse is making our sign (Free of charge), and a church from NC has bought and is shipping a steeple. We are rejoicing as we see the Lord put it all together!

We would like to thank each of you for your faithful prayers and your continued support for our family and for the cause of Christ!
